



Kent Scouts Volunteer Award Requirements



- You must complete a minimum of **25** hours work to achieve your bronze award
- You must complete a minimum of **50** hours work to achieve your silver award
- You must complete a minimum of **100** hours work to achieve your gold award
- You must complete a minimum of **250** hours work to achieve your diamond award
- You must complete a minimum of **500** hours work to achieve your platinum award

To gain your hours for this award you must volunteer to help people
for example you could:

- Cut your neighbours grass
- Clean your neighbours car
- Help at a residential home
- Help at beavers or cubs
- Fundraise for your group or district
- Help out at a community event
- Clean your local park
- Pick up litter around your school

Remember Volunteering is voluntary and you are not doing it for money.

What else do you need to do?

1. Get a copy of the log sheet from the Kent scout website
2. Ask your leader if it is safe to help out and volunteer where you want to
3. Fill out the sheet with the hours that you have completed
4. Ask your leader to sign the sheet to confirm you have completed the hours
5. Once the sheet is complete, send it to the county office: **Kent Scouts, Lower Grange Farm, Grange Lane, Sandling, Maidstone, Kent, ME14 3DA**
